The Daniel Island Community Fund was established in 2000 with the mission of providing funding for civic and social programs supporting Daniel Island and its greater geographic community including Thomas Island, Huger, Wando and the Cainhoy Peninsula.

Resources are granted only to legitimate and accountable organizations that support the following community-enhancement categories:

Neighbor to Neighbor: The Daniel Island Community Fund

- · An island-led initiative that identifies opportunities and distributes resources for agencies supporting its surrounding neighbors.
- A private 501(C)4 that is financially supported by community enhancement fees from sales of existing Daniel Island homes, homesites and commercial properties and from interest collected from escrow accounts.
- Individuals and businesses who wish to support the Fund may contribute to the Daniel Island Community Foundation, a 501(C)3 that provides additional financial support for the Fund.
- An all-volunteer Board of Directors oversees the Community Fund's strict application, review and allocation process.



The Fund has recently supported the following service organizations:

CAINHOY ELEMENTARY AND MIDDLE SCHOOLS — Provided funding for purchase of much needed classroom supplies

TRIDENT AREA BOYS AND GIRLS CLUBS — Initiated and supported after school programs at Cainhoy Elementary/Middle School

UNITED METHODIST RELIEF FUND — Provided funding for housing assistance to two families on St. Thomas Island

JUNIOR ACHIEVEMENT — Initiated and supported a program at Cainhoy Elementary/Middle School
